Australia has the highest uptake of household solar in the world. Rooftop solar has become a crucial part of Australia's renewable energy.

Rebates and incentives

If you want to install a rooftop solar system at your home or business, you might be able to get an upfront discount on the purchase price of your system.

Under the Small-scale Renewable Energy Scheme, <u>eligible systems</u> can claim small-scale technology certificates (STCs). Registered agents can help you get a discount on the purchase price of your system if you <u>assign your right to claim STCs to them</u>.

Once your system is installed you can also choose to sell some of the electricity it generates back to the grid. This is a feed-in tariff.

Depending on your location, you might also be eligible for more rebates. You can find out what rebates are available in each state and territory at <u>Smart Energy Programs</u>.

You can also choose to buy and sell STCs yourself.


