

State Level


- ✓ The Government adopted the Master plan for the development of Gas Transport System of Montenegro with the Report on Strategic Assessment of environmental impact and the Guidelines for Planning Priority Investments in Gas Projects.
- ✓ The Power Exchange has been established.



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The Ministry of Economy transposing:

- ✓ Regulation (EU) No 543/2013 of 14 June 2013 on submission and publication of data in electricity markets
- ✓ Regulation (EU) No 347/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 April 2013 on guidelines for trans-European energy infrastructure
- ✓ Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 of 24 July 2015 establishing a guideline on capacity allocation and congestion management
- ✓ Regulation (EU) 2016/1719 of 26 September 2016 establishing a guideline on forward capacity allocation



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Activities within the Agency

- ✓ Adoption of secondary legislation for electricity in accordance with Energy Law is completed
- ✓ RAE has signed two memoranda of cooperation, with the Italian regulator in May and the Bulgarian regulator in September
- ✓ The process of CGES certification is in progress
- ✓ The Harmonised auction rules have been approved
