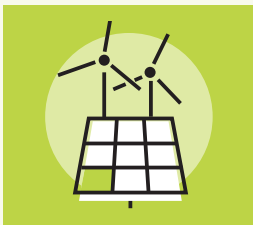
SUSTAINING THE MOMENTUM



44% of the total population without access to electricity live in countries with robust sustainable energy policy. **50% of fragile and conflict-affected** countries improved their **electricity access policies** between 2017 and 2019.



While only **15% of the clean cooking access-deficit** countries have achieved advanced policy frameworks, those countries represent more than **50%** of the unserved population globally.



Globally, **80%** of countries have a **renewable energy** legal framework in place, but only **40%** of them have a clear target or strategy for the use of renewable energy in the heating and cooling sector.



Nearly **70%** of the countries with robust policies have adopted energy efficiency related policy plans.



Sub-Saharan Africa accounts for **9** of the top 10 performers, with improvements driven by progress on electricity access and renewable energy.
